
Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2013 scheduled during
April-June, 2013- deletion of duplicate (repeated) electors

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to say that after running of de-duplication software in the three ACs of Bhubaneswar namely 112- Bhubaneswar (Central), 113- Bhubaneswar(North)and 114- Ekamra Bhubaneswar, it is seen that there are 73,290 voters registered in these ACs, who are also registered at other ACs of the State having same name and relation's name and age of \pm 3 years.. It may be possible that such voters might have shifted to Bhubaneswar from other ACs and got themselves registered in the electoral roll of the above 3 ACs of Bhubaneswar, without deleting their name from the previous location. The AC wise list of such voters is mailed herewith in Excel sheet.

2. You are requested to verify the electors mentioned in the Assembly Constituency under your jurisdiction, conduct proper field inquiry and delete such name if the voter is not found ordinarily resident in that polling area and has shifted to Bhubaneswar.
