Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls with reference to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2013 as qualifying date during 8 April- 1 June 2013- extension of period for filing claims and objections

Madam / Sir,

Keeping in view the peculiar problems faced by BLOs in urban areas and general public due to the prevailing heat wave, Election Commission of India vide Notification No. 23/OR/2012 dated 07.05.2013 has been pleased to extend the period for filing claims and objections of the ongoing Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls with reference to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 as qualifying date, **upto 21<sup>st</sup> May 2013** (Tuesday) for giving more time for house to house verification.

2. This extended period should be utilised for ensuring:

- i. Achievement of 100% photo coverage through collection of photographs/ photography of non-photo electors;
- ii. deletion of all dead/ shifted / repeated electors by following due procedure;
- iii. completion of data entry of all deletions, corrections (including photo merging) and addition of electors

3. All the applications already received from BLOs including verified working copies should be handed over to concerned computer firm for data entry, while they are simultaneously being disposed of by AERO/ EROs. The EROs should immediately analyse polling station wise deletions identified and photograph collected from non-photo electors and make special strategies for polling stations with low photo coverage and low deletions to improve the electoral roll during this extended period.

This should be brought to the notice of all AEROs, Supervisory Officers and BLOs immediately for their guidance. The district units of recognised political parties should be informed about this extended period, and requested to file claims and objections (if any) to the concerned Electoral Registration Officer cum Sub-Collector within the said date.


