

Minutes of the meeting with Electoral Roll Observers held on 29.5.2013 at 11A.M on Special Summary Revision in the Office Chamber of Chief Electoral Officer, Odisha

The meeting was chaired by Chief Electoral Officer. The members present in the meeting is at Annexure – A.

1. Initiating the discussion, CEO informed that the time schedule for the Special Summary Revision which is under progress have been revised by the Election Commission of India. As per the revised schedule, the period of receiving claims and objections has been extended to 31st May, 2013. Disposal of claims and objections by 10.06.2013 & up dating the data base, merging of photographs, updating control tables and preparation and printing of Supplementary list by 20th June,2013 and final publication of Rolls by 1st July, 2013. (**Annexure-B**)

2. As per on line information given by EROs till 28th May, 2013, 6 lakh voters have been identified for addition, 11.5 lakh voters for deletion and 6.1 lakh voters for correction. District-wise information on the progress of household to household survey is enclosed as Annexure-C.

3. The following points were prioritized for follow up action by the Observers in the extended period for special revision.

(a) Ensure that information for 100% of the households is updated in the data base.

(b) For 3.12 lakh form-6 collected from 20+ age group, 100% verification regarding Part-4 must be ensured and ERO should also be advised to use "**search facility**" in the website to cross check and ensure that none of these new entries are repeated entries.

(c) For 6.1 lakh Form-8 collected, the EROs must ensure that 100% verification by the BLOs after the data entry by the vendor is done at the Block level before these entries are taken to the Electoral Roll Data base.

(d) There is urgent need to identify all the cases fit for deletion as per the data collected by the BLOs and to update this information on the website.

CEO emphasized that in all the cases for deletion of the name of voter from the Electoral Roll, due procedure as prescribed by ECI **must be** followed by the EROs. After the meeting with the Collectors on 15.05.2013, ECI's comprehensive instructions on the procedure to be followed before deletion has been issued again to the DEOs and EROs on 20.05.2013. The

Observers must ensure that the instructions of ECI are followed meticulously without exception by the EROs before deleting the name of voter from the Electoral Roll.

(e) The Observers for Ganjam, Khurda, Nayagarh, Cuttack, Kendrapara, Puri, Bhadrak, Dhenkanal, Bolangir and Nuapada were advised to take a more critical review regarding identification of names for deletion as the EP Ratio of these districts, as per the information given up to 28.5.2013 is still very high. All out efforts must be made to bring the EP Ratio in these districts nearer to the Census figure. The Supervisory Officers should be utilized more effectively in these districts to ensure identification of names for deletion.

(f) The drive for collection of photographs of non-PER voters should continue vigorously so as to achieve 100% PER coverage.














Final Publication of Rolls	1 st July, 2013


