DIRECTION

No. 576/3/EVM/2014/SDR-Vol.I:— Whereas, Section 61A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, provides that the giving and recording of votes by Voting Machines in such manner as may be prescribed, may be adopted in such constituencies as the Election Commission of India may, having regard to the circumstances of each case specify; and

2. Whereas, the Commission has considered the circumstances in **all the Assembly Constituencies of Haryana and Maharashtra and 39-Beed Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra, 13-Kandhamal Parliamentary Constituency of Odisha, 58-Kanubari (ST)**

Assembly Constituency of Arunachal Pradesh, 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency of Manipur, 11-Northern Angami-II (ST) Assembly Constituency of Nagaland, 8-Kairana Assembly Constituency of Uttar Pradesh and 69-Rajkot West Assembly Constituency of Gujarat, and is satisfied that sufficient number of Electronic Voting Machines are available for taking the poll in the abovementioned Parliamentary and Assembly Constituencies. The polling personnel are well trained in efficient handling of the Electronic Voting Machines and the electors are also fully conversant with the operation of the Electronic Voting Machines;

3. Now, therefore, the Election Commission of India hereby specifies each of the 90 Assembly Constituencies of Haryana and 288 Assembly Constituencies of Maharashtra at the current General Elections to the Haryana and Maharashtra State Legislative Assemblies and 39-Beed Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra, 13-Kandhamal Parliamentary Constituency of Odisha, 58-Kanubari (ST) Assembly Constituency of Arunachal Pradesh, 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency of Manipur, 11-Northern Angami-II (ST) Assembly Constituency of Nagaland, 8-Kairana Assembly Constituency of Uttar Pradesh and 69-Rajkot West Assembly Constituency of Gujarat, from where bye-elections are being held, as the constituencies in which the votes at the current General Elections to the State Legislative Assemblies of Haryana and Maharashtra and the bye-elections to Parliamentary Constituencies and Assembly Constituencies of the said States, notified on 19-09-2014 & 20-09-2014, shall be given and recorded by means of Electronic Voting Machines in the manner prescribed under the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, and the supplementary instructions issued by the Commission from time to time on the subject.
